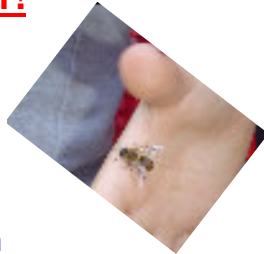

## Apitherapy offers Healthy Alternatives

### Raw Honey vs. Pasteurized Honey

Raw, unprocessed honey, straight from the hive, has been used worldwide for thousands of years to promote healing.

Raw honey contains active enzymes, vitamins and volatile chemical constituents that are destroyed or removed by heating and processing. Raw honey also contains variable percentages of pollen, propolis, which add vitamins and beneficial phytochemicals.

The general rule of thumb is that children under twelve months of age should not be fed raw honey as there is a risk of botulism. The spores of the *Clostridium botulinum* bacteria can be found in honey, and when ingested by an infant, the spores can release a toxin that causes botulism.

**Common Uses:** Although it is a delicious topper on toast, ice-cream or blended in a fruit smoothie, honey has been used to treat sore throats, colds, flue, skin and stomach ulcers, diarrhea and other digestive disorders and for dressing wounds.
