There is still time to register for Honeyland Canada's introductory beekeeping classes beginning April 2005. As the number of large-scale beekeepers decreases, the need for hobbyists and small-scale beekeepers in Canada has increased significantly.



This course is designed for individuals that would like to learn the basics of honeybee biology, hive product production, and the fundamentals of beekeeping.

It is suitable for the hobbyist beekeeper, gardeners, and those interested in part-time or full-time employment opportunities in the beekeeping industry. At the end of the course, participants will be able to manage up to 20 hives. Advanced level courses will also be offered for those who wish to pursue beekeeping further.

The classes will take place at Honeyland Canada, 17617 Ford Road, Pitt Meadows, one evening per week (Mondays or Tuesdays); plus three, 2 hour field days by appointment.
