Honeyland Canada is accepting applications from businesses, associations, service groups, churches, volunteer organizations, crafters and other vendors to secure a booth at our 2nd Annual Bees & Blueberry Festival.

Participation in this event gives preference to businesses, associations, organizations that provide healthy lifestyle ideas for families, farm fresh products and / or agricultural awareness. Preference is given to food vendors that provide visitors with healthy food choices.

Please review the terms and conditions listed below and complete the enclosed *Registration Form*. Applications will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis and the final determination will be made by the Bees & Blueberry Festival Committee (we will do our best to avoid duplication of products and services)

VENDORS TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING...

1. Booth set-up will be from 7AM – 9:00AM, Saturday, July 29 and Sunday, July 30
2. Each display space will be approximately 10 feet deep x 10 feet long.
3. Each participant is expected to provide their tables, chairs, signage and tent (rentals available through the festival coordinator)
4. Each participant will be responsible for trash clean up during and after the event. There will be trash containers available.
5. Electricity is limited. All participants requesting electricity will be supplied on a first-come, first-served basis. Please specify if 220 power is required.
6. Honeyland Canada does not provide insurance coverage for your booth. Each participant is responsible for their own goods.
7. Payment: Vendor understands that Vendor's payment in full of all fees and this signed Agreement must all be received by the Festival office on or before July 20, 2006 in order to be considered for the Bees & Blueberry Festival. In the event, the food vendor will be paying Honeyland 20% of gross sales, 20% of gross sales will be collected at the end of each day.
8. Right of Termination: If Vendor violates any terms in this Agreement, the Committee shall have the right to terminate this Agreement, immediately close Vendor's booth(s), and retain exhibitor fees.
